2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Buprenorphine hydrochloride is a potent opiate analgesic. Precautions must be taken and procedures adopted to prevent excessive exposure.

Each ml contains 300µg/ml buprenorphine hydrochloride in a 5% glucose solution at pH 4-5.



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4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Skin contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use.

Ingestion: If swallowed, wash out mouth with water provided person is conscious. Call a physician.

After eye contact: In case of contact with eyes, flush with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Procedures for clean up: Wear gloves and avoid skin contact. Absorb small spills on spill pillows, sand, sawdust or other suitable absorbing material. Dispose of by incineration or as special waste in deep land-fill.

Handling: Buprecare is a controlled drug.

Storage: Store in an appropriate secure cool place. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

In case of accidental self-injection or ingestion, seek medical advice immediately and show the package leaflet or the label to the physician.



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Following eye contamination or skin contact, wash thoroughly with cold running water, seek medical advice if irritation persists.
